






**Programme**

#### STUDENT DATA PRIVACY POLICY

It is the policy of the Fridley Public School Board that the District comply with the Federal Family Rights and Privacy Act and Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. Parents/guardians or eligible student has the right to file a complaint with the US Department of Education regarding an alleged failure by the District to comply with federal and state law. A complete copy of Policy 515 Protection and Privacy of Pupil Records is available on the website.

Educational records which identify or could be used to identify a student other than directory information, may not be released to members of the public without the written permission of the student's parents or guardians or the student if s/he is 18, attends a post-secondary institution, is married, or has graduated. This general rule is subject to specific and limited exceptions which are set out in district policy.

Directory Information may be released to the public without permission of the student, parent, or guardian. Directory Information includes: the student's name, date and place of birth, class designation Fridley School District or grade level, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, photograph, and the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended. Directory information does not include data which references religion, race, color, social position or nationality.

It is the practice of district to release educational records to educational institutions to which as student intends to enroll or has enrolled including suspension and expulsion records without notifying the student or parent/guardians prior to the transfer. Upon request, the district will provide the student or guardians with a copy of the educational records which have been transferred and provide an opportunity for a hearing to challenge the content of those records.

If a student or parent/guardian does not want some or all of this data to be made public, they must notify their school principal in writing within 30 days of enrollment. If they choose to deny release of all directory information, the student will be excluded from such published lists as honor rolls, press releases regarding sports achievements, honors received, and athletic/arts/music/theater/academic printed and electronic programs/publications. A request to deny release of information must be requested in writing each year.


